This year, we are rolling out the 2019 Partnership Program that is wide open to applicants across the Province, from where our members live, which meet our funding categories and criteria.

Eligibility

The **Trades NL Education School Grant** will support school initiatives that provide student enrichment opportunities through programming, resources or equipment.

20 – Grants up to \$1,000 will be awarded to schools within Newfoundland & Labrador.

Approved funding must be measurable, impactful or tangible.

Ineligible request would include administration, travel or fundraisers.



Application Process

Applications will open on February 1st, 2019 and close on March 1st, 2019.

Successful applicants will be notified by March 30, 2019 and must enter into a formal gift agreement with Trades NL before any funds will be disbursed.
